smooth player.

#7 - 5'6", only grade 10 but plays with more ability than most grade 12. confident, strong with

the ball, good decisions, fast, will work on outside shot but anything within 15 feet is in the

hoop, handled press nearly as well as #5.

Team - strong coaching staff and it shows. After sluggish first half just blew away Scarlett.

17-4 run to start second half. Players have a system and really operate well in both a set

offense and a motion offense. Defense tends to rely on the 6'1" force down low but makes good

choices while in the zone.

Girls 2

#4 - 5'8", solid defense, had 5 or 6 steals, decent shot.

#20 - 6', good shot, good positioning on D always between ball and hoop but has trouble with

cross court cutters and making the proper switch in man to man D, strong footwork.

Team - Player rotation was so fast that players hardly got warm before being pulled. Some players

showed their disgust for this system while on the bench. Hard to really tell where the talent is

with some of these girls as they got 4 or 5 runs down the floor and then they were back on the

bench. Almost a case of over coaching things and they fell apart in the second half even with the

fresh legs.
