A recruiting package with a focus on the United States. We start with an evaluation of talent, move onto discussions with coaches and a game plan is established. NCAA and NJCAA schools will be contacted, your profile kept up to date and you will be given advice when the offers come in.

The NCAA is made up of 331 Division 1 schools, 291 Division 2 schools and 429 Division 3 schools. Of these schools there are 61 Division 1 schools playing lacrosse, 35 schools at the Division 2 level and 164 at Division 3.

The club level has exploded in recent years for mens lacrosse and the MCLA has 213 schools in two divisions.

The NCAA lacrosse is an unique situation as the opportunities for womens lacrosse are growing at a much greater rate than in mens lacrosse. There are 91 Division 1 schools playing lacrosse, 58 at the Division 2 level and 204 at Division 3.
